MRC is committed to complying with the principles of the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1984, as well as all other relevant legislation and regulations.


Management will:

- Ensure that safety is seen as a core value by all employees and nothing takes precedence over the safety of employees
- Develop, review and maintain a suitable OH&S Management System, including standards, procedures and work instructions to ensure our objectives in OH&S are met
- Communicate this Policy to all employees and contractors, display it in work areas, and make it available to all stakeholders
- Ensure visible and committed leadership at all levels of the business, and set clear accountability for maintaining a safety supportive culture
- Provide OH&S training to ensure employees and contractors are aware of their OH&S roles and responsibilities
- Ensure suitably trained, qualified and skilled personnel are engaged to undertake the applicable tasks
- Provide appropriate safety equipment and personal protective equipment

Workers will:

- Take reasonable care for their own and their fellow workers’ health and safety
- Follow safe work procedures, instructions and rules
- Utilise and participate in the Company’s discussions, tools and safety activities
- Actively participate in safety training
- Actively participate in communication, planning, review and identification of OH&S issues
- Report health and safety hazards
- Report all injuries and incidents, including near-misses
- Use safety equipment and personal protective equipment as instructed

The Company unequivocally accepts that all workers should be allowed to enter the workplace and participate in a harm-free environment and leave without injury. This goal can only be achieved through best practice policy and education and co-operative and collective engagement with all workers.
